The application package shall also include at least two supporting letters, including one from the student’s major professor.

The application must meet the stated requirement of stated to the left. The judges will also consider:

- Technical merits of project
- Innovation
- Presentation/description of project in proposal
- Use of funds
- Recommendations/supporting letters
- Potential benefit to INCE (future presentation or technical papers)
- Potential economic impact
- Potential impact on the field of noise control/ acoustical conditioning
