



INCE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION FORM

The INCE Student Scholarship is granted to a college student studying noise control or architectural acoustics in the United States of America who, through personal qualifications and proposed research experience, is judged to exhibit the highest potential for performing research benefiting some aspect of noise control and promoting its usefulness to society.

Awardees receive a scholarship prize of \$6,000.

ELIGIBILITY.

To be eligible for the Scholarship a person shall have been accepted to or currently enrolled in any college or university that offers undergraduate or graduate study in Noise Control or Architectural Acoustics. Preference will be given to citizens of the United States of America. You must be eighteen (18) years or older.

Qualification for the Scholarship requires submission of an application form with description of a planned course of study including the reasons why this field of study is being pursued.

Three reference letters shall be provided from persons familiar with the student's work. One letter shall be from the student's advising or major professor.

Membership in INCE-USA is not required. If the recipient is not an INCE-USA member at the time the award is made, a complimentary one-year student membership will be awarded as a part of the Scholarship.

CRITERIA FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP.

The recipient of the Scholarship will be that individual who, through personal qualifications and a proposed research experience, is judged to exhibit the highest potential for performing research benefiting some aspect of noise control

and promoting its usefulness to society. Preference will be given to females and underrepresented minorities in the noise control profession. INCE-USA's employees, Board Members, and their immediate family are not eligible to participate in the scholarship program.

ADMINISTRATION.

The recipient of the award will be notified before that year's conference. The amount of the award will be \$6,000 paid to the student's university account. The payment will be made at the time the scholarship is awarded.

DEADLINES.

Applications for the INCE Scholarship shall be submitted by the following deadline:

11:59 PM PDT December 15, 2022

Applications received after this deadline will not be accepted. Recommendation forms and letters shall be submitted directly to the INCE-USA Office by the student's references and are due by the deadline. Incomplete scholarship applications will not be considered. All application documentation should be submitted electronically to the INCE-USA Vice President of Honors & Awards at vp_awards@inceusa.org.
