ABOUT THE APPLICATION: Special Student Session – Presentations of Classic Papers in Noise Control

Each year, INCE-USA sponsors a special session of student presentations of classic papers in noise control. A submitted paper is **not** required, but an abstract should be submitted, and the student must be registered for the conference. The application deadline is the same as the conference abstract submission deadline; please visit this year's conference website to submit an abstract. The winner will receive \$1,000 USD if she or he attends the Awards Ceremony in person (check conference schedule for date/time). See last page of this document for the Contest Rules.

COMPETITION RULES AND INFORMATION.

SUBJECT OF PAPER

You must select one of the papers in the approved paper list (separate document) for your presentation. There may be multiple presentations of the same paper. Once the abstract has been submitted, switching papers is not permitted.

AUTHORSHIP OF PRESENTATION

The presentation must be compiled by and presented by the student. The student **must be registered as a student at a university or college at the time of the conference.**

PRESENTATION AND ABSTRACT TITLE

Format for the title of paper should be: "Overview of <original author list>'s <year> paper on <original paper title>"

ABSTRACT

This should highlight the main thrust of the original paper and the focus of the presentation, which could include additional work that has been done by the student presenter. Additional work could include reproduction of the results in the paper, additional analysis, or showing how the original paper has influenced subsequent research or noise control practice, etc.

DEADLINE

An abstract for the presentation must be submitted by the **conference abstract submission deadline.** If the deadline is extended, then the new date will be used as the deadline for the submission of your entry.

JUDGES

All decisions of the INCE-USA judges are final. The Institute reserves the right not to make an award should presentations not satisfy minimum levels of expectations by the panel of judges.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judges will evaluate the presentations by considering:

- i. The judges' perceptions of the student's understanding of the technical content of the classic paper.
- ii. The student's understanding of the impact of the research reported in the paper.
- iii. The quality of the communication of the technical content of the classic paper.
- iv. The quality of the slides.
- v. The clarity and presentation style of the presenter.
- vi. The quality of any additional analysis performed.

AWARDS CEREMONY

All competition entrants must present their papers in person or virtually in the session to which their papers are assigned. They must also be present in person at the awards ceremony of the conference (check the conference schedule) to receive their prize.
